



Neighborhood Mini Grants Program FAQs

What are the Neighborhood Mini Grants?

These grants of between \$100 and \$1,000 will support collaborative, neighborhood-based projects that support the safety and livability of the community while honoring neighborhood culture, traditions and values.

Who can apply?

Informal resident groups (e.g. block clubs), neighborhood associations, and nonprofit organizations with an annual budget of \$100,000 or less. A Fiduciary is required for groups that do not have 501 (c)(3) status (the \$100,000 annual budget does not apply to the Fiduciary). See the application packet for more information.

Can an existing program receive a grant?

Yes! Our goal is support the great work already taking place. While existing programs can apply for a grant, funds received cannot be used to cover previous expenses. Funds must be used for new efforts and expenses.

How can the funds be used?

To create, plan, organize and implement a proposal for community enhancement projects. Examples of eligible projects include: tree planting, resume training, after-school tutoring. Examples of ineligible projects include: staff salary/wage expenses, events that charge admission, political / lobbying efforts, and buying alcohol.

When will I find out if I received a grant?

Funding decisions will be made within 45 days of submission. Applicants will be notified, in writing, about approved or denied funding decisions.

What is the AGR mission, values and focus areas?

Mission: In partnership with residents, businesses, and community organization, AGR seeks to widen pathways so that all residents have a greater opportunity to participate in and benefit from community growth.

Focus Areas: Jobs & entrepreneurship, Housing, Education and Community Wellbeing
